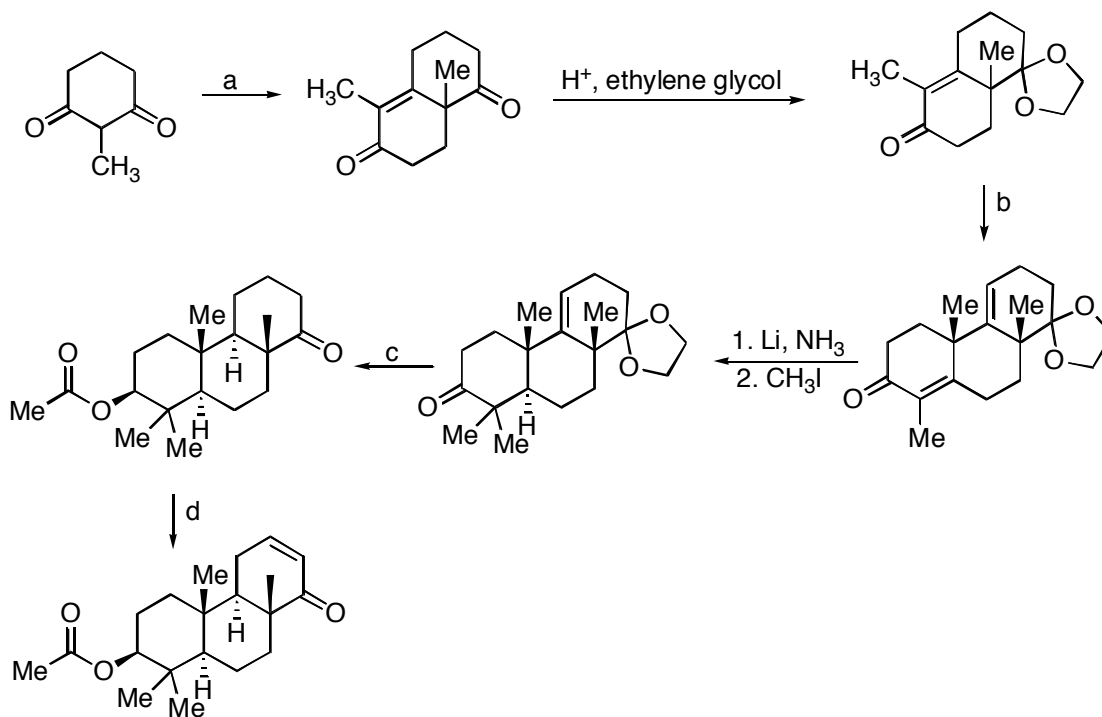
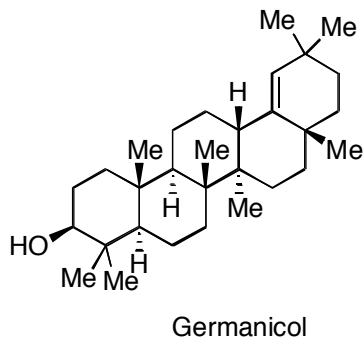
2. Write the products for the following reactions.



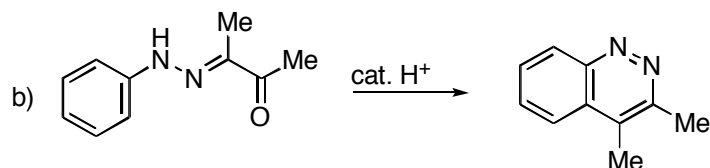
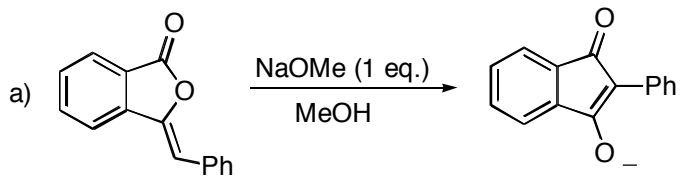
3. Identify the intermediates *A* and *B* in the transformation below and show how they are formed (mechanism).
